

BASIC ADULT LEADER OUTDOOR ORIENTATION TRAINING (BALOO)

Saturday, April 5th through Sunday 6th, 2025.

This one-and-a-half day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. BALOO training consists of an <u>online pre-requisite component in addition</u> to an overnight and hands on practical experience. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the discovery of the necessary tools to help units carry our successful camping experience. Completion of this course is mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult on a Pack overnighter.

Participants will be **camping overnight on Saturday** and should bring tent, overnight sleeping supplies, chair, clipboard notepad pen/pencil and CUB Minded to the Outdoor program, Field uniform (Class A) and or activity/unit t-shirt recommended; Inclement weather is possible, wear appropriate gear Please wear comfortable closed toe shoes & hat. Your classroom is outdoors.
